Oslo Bulk is pleased to announce the purchase of four 9,300 dwt MPP vessels from Bockstiegel Reederei in Germany. The vessels will be renamed Oslo Carrier 1,2,3 4 and will be delivered to Oslo Bulk in January / February 2013.

The vessels are built in 2010/2011 in China, ice classed and equipped with 60 ton cranes combinable to 120 tons.
